- Practice facility for the Wizards
- Game and practice facility for the Mystics
- ★ Possible location for an NBA Development League team

## Entertainment & Sports Arena: Project Update

- ★ The current design has been approved by the Commission of Fine Arts (CFA)
- ★ Infrastructure work is underway on the site
- ★ Construction on the ESA is scheduled to begin in early June

## Managing Construction of the Entertainment and Sports Arena



#### Preconstruction Activities

- Subcontractor Outreach
  - Bidder Information Meeting on December 15
  - Pre Bid Meeting on April 11
  - Bid Invitations to CBEs sent by DSLBD
- Bidding Underway
  - Received over 100 Bids for 20 Bid Packages
  - Awarded Design Assist Packages for Precast,
     Structural Steel and MEP
  - On Target to Reach 50% CBE Participation



#### Preconstruction Activities

- Community Involvement
  - Ongoing recruitment for Trade-Specific Opportunities
    - Workshops in March and April to recruit Ward 8 residents for opportunities
    - To date, 19 DC residents have been accepted for apprenticeships by the iron workers, carpenters, painters and glaziers
  - This project has a First Source Agreement requirement
    - Must use DOES as the First Source for recruitment referral and placement of DC residents


#### Construction Activities

## Entertainment & Sports Arena Overview: CBA Update

- ★ 23 of 25 organizations invited responded and named a representative to negotiate the CBA
- ★ Series of Committee Meetings and Sub-Committee Meetings were held between April 2016 - February 2017 (Total of 18 meetings)
  - Over 3000 residents engaged
    - Email
    - RoboCalls
    - Surveys
- ★ Visits to population serving institutions (Schools, Recreation Centers, etc.)
- ★ Four rounds of negotiations before reaching agreement on the terms



## Entertainment & Sports Arena Overview: CBA Update

- ★ The Parties have agreed to terms including:
  - Events DC shall provide \$40,000 per year over 19 years (\$760,000) to fund scholarships/internships for young adults residing in Ward 8
  - Events DC shall provide \$25,000 per year over 19 years (\$475,000) to Ward 8 organizations for career development services
  - Events DC shall provide \$50,000 per year over 19 years (\$950,000) to fund Congress Heights Day and other Ward 8 community events
  - The community shall be entitled to use the arena for community-based events at least 5 days per year
